





Who is Sathya Sai Baba?

- Born as Sathya Narayana Raju on the 23rd of November 1926, in Puttaparthi.
- From a very young age, Sathya was a compassionate child and ideal student with extraordinary spiritual wisdom.
- On the 20th of October 1940, he made a historic declaration at the age of 14.



Historic Declaration



"I am no longer your Sathya, I am Sai. I do not belong to you. I have My work. My devotees are calling Me. I am going. I can no longer stay here..."

- "I have a 'Task': to foster all mankind and ensure for all of them lives full of bliss.
- I have a 'Vow': to lead all who stray away from the right path again into goodness and save them.
- I am attached to a 'Work' that I love: to remove the sufferings of the poor and grant them what they lack."



I have come to tell you about this unitary faith, this Atmic principle, this path of Love, this duty of Love, this obligation to Love."

"You will learn that I am love (Prema) itself; that I give only one thing, bliss (Ananda) through love (Prema). My task is to distribute solace, courage and peace (Shanti). That is to say, My characteristics are the ancient authentic ones, only the manifested form is new."
